

Minimum Connection Time:

MCT is as per airline rules. Please allow enough time for passengers to go between the airplane and the train station. Connection time is included from airport to train station in GDS.

Eligibility:

Infants 2 years of age and under ride free without a ticket if no seat is required. The infant must be accompanied on all services in the same compartment by an adult.

Child fare is not available.

Adult fare only.

No group bookings allowed.



No applicable discounts for airline staff.

Refunds are according to Airline Tariff Rules.

Services:

Passengers can travel in Economy class or Business class on VIA Rail.

Passengers in Economy can enjoy travel with free Wi-Fi, an electrical socket at the seat, and access to the snack cart.

Passengers in Business class can enjoy travel with free Wi-Fi, an electrical socket at the seat, access to the Business lounge at the departing station, spacious seats with more legroom, and meal and bar services.

Check-in Process:

Check-in prior to departure is essential to ensure a smooth travel experience.




Figure 4: Check-in Page

Passengers must check-in to retrieve their actual travel documents (Figure 3). Check-in can be done beginning 72-hours prior to departure. Check-in is done on <https://check-in.accesrail.com/#/step1> (Figure 4) using the passenger’s name as it appears in the booking and either the booking reference or 13-digit ticket number.

When passengers check-in they will receive their travel document and a second page with important information regarding the ticket’s conditions, as well, as instructions on how to transfer between the airports and the train station.

Passengers who depart from/arrive at Pearson Airport or Pierre Elliot Trudeau Airport will

receive a second page that contain instructions on how to transfer between the airport and the train station. As well, passengers who depart from/arrive at Pearson Airport will receive a second ticket for the UP Express.

Seat reservations are included.

How to Go Between the Train Station and the Airport:

Passengers who arrive at/depart from the airport will receive a second page with instructions on how to transfer between the airport and the train station.

Passengers who arrive at/depart from **Toronto Pearson Airport** will receive instructions on how to take the UP Express between the airport and Toronto Union Station. The ticket for the UP Express will be included in the travel documents once the passenger has checked-in. The UP Express departs from Terminal 1. Passengers at Terminal 1 can make their way through Pearson Airport to the UP Express station by following the signs in the airport.

Passengers who arrive at/depart from Terminal 3 can take the free Terminal Link train to Terminal 1. Travel time between Pearson Airport and Union Station is approximately 25 minutes with trains departing




Figure 5: UP Express Ticket Example

every 15 minutes or so.

UP Express trains are fully wheelchair accessible, with trains featuring accessible washrooms and spaces for mobility aids. All stations are designed to be accessible, with signage and information available.




Figure 5: Toronto Pearson Airport Map



Passengers who arrive at/depart from **Montreal Pierre Elliot Trudeau Airport** will receive instructions on how to take the free shuttle, Indigo Express, between the airport and Montreal Dorval Station. For passengers who arrive on domestic flights, the Indigo shuttle can be taken from Arrivals at the VINCI Park/VIA Rail sign, Post 2 that is located at the taxi and shuttle area. For passengers who arrive on international

flights, the Indigo shuttle can be taken from Arrivals at the VINCI Park/VIA Rail sign, Post 3 that is located at the taxi and shuttle area. Travel time between Montreal-Trudeau Airport and Montreal Dorval Station is approximately 10 to 20 minutes with the shuttle departing at regular intervals.

From Montréal-Trudeau Airport to Dorval Station

INDIGO The Indigo free shuttle service between Montreal-Trudeau Airport to the Dorval VIA Rail Station runs at regular intervals. The approximate travel time is 10 minutes, depending upon the traffic conditions.

The shuttle posts are located at:

- Domestic flight: Arrivals level, at the VINCI Park / VIA Rail sign, Post 2 located in the taxis and shuttles area.
- International flight: Arrivals level, VINCI Park / VIA Rail sign, Post 3 located in the taxis and shuttles area.

The free shuttle service from Dorval VIA Rail Station to the Montreal-Trudeau Airport can be called using the direct line on the outside wall at Dorval Station (514-589-3341). You will be dropped off at the appropriate departures area (please tell the driver which airline you are using). [More info](#)

From Toronto-Pearson Airport to Union Station

UP The new Union Pearson (UP) Express rail link connecting Toronto Pearson Airport with Union Station in downtown Toronto is the best option. It takes 25 minutes, and departs every 15 minutes between 5:30am and 1:00am daily.

- The connection between Terminal 1 and Terminal 3 of Toronto Pearson International Airport is provided by the Terminal Link train, a free service. UP Express station is directly adjacent to the Terminal Link train station in Terminal 1.
- With only two brief stops at Bloor and Weston GO Stations, UP Express is the fastest and most reliable way to get between Toronto Pearson Airport and Union Station.

Luggage:

VIA Rail luggage rules apply. It is the passenger's responsibility to collect their checked bags from the airport and carry them to their respective train and vice-versa. Customer is responsible for their own baggage during the train journey.

On-board Meals:

Passengers in Economy class have access to the snack cart where they can purchase snacks and drinks on certain trains.

Passengers in Business class have access to meal and bar services.

Mobility Assistance:

Mobility assistance for passengers who require it must be booked at least 48 hours prior to departure. Mobility assistance can be booked by calling +1-888-VIA-RAIL (+1-888-842-7245). For passengers with assistance dogs, please indicate this when requesting mobility assistance.

Delays:

In case of train delays, passengers must contact the issuing airline carrier for assistance.

In case of flight delays, passengers may exchange their ticket for another departure (subject to space availability) up to 24 hours from the original departure time with no service charges. Passenger must go to Via Rail ticket counter to make this arrangement.

SSR Message:

Please note that the SSR message will contain check-in information.

Use SSR "WCBD" or "WCBW" or "WCHC" or "WCLB" to request a wheelchair place in the long-distance train.



FAQ:

1. Is VIA Rail a BUS or TRN?
VIA Rail is a train (TRN) service.
2. Do I have to check-in?
Yes, passengers must check-in in order to receive their actual travel document which they will use to board the train.
3. Are seat reservations included?
Yes, seat reservations are included.
